Explanation of Project

Background

As a graduating student in finance, Thierry brought more to the table than his peers. First, he'd had three summer internships with a global manufacturer – one in the U.S. and two overseas. Second, he was fluent in three languages. Third, he graduated with honors. And fourth, he'd held several leadership positions in school.

Formatting

Since this is a classic-style resume, all of the formatting enhancements were created with simple shading and borders available in Word. All content is ATS-friendly. Finance is a fairly conservative role, so I used subtle shades of blue/grey to add visual interest and guide the eye down the page.

Summary and Branding Statement

Below the headline that indicates Thierry's career target, I included a branding statement to highlight his value to the company. While *all* analysts help leaders make sound decisions, I wanted the reader to see that Thierry understood his role and its importance to a company's success. This requires thoroughness and care to produce accurate findings, so I included these adverbs in the branding statement.

Below the branding statement, I created a short paragraph and bullet points to summarize Thierry's qualifications. The items in bold are differentiators.

Education Section

Since Thierry is a new grad, I expanded his education section with relevant coursework, class projects, and the leadership roles he'd held. All of these were significant and warranted using the majority of page one.

Related Experience and Internships

In his most recent internship, Thierry had been given the opportunity to make true contributions to the company — working side by side with the CFO to resolve problems. To highlight these, I used headings "Key Project" and "Key Challenge," with bullet points for his specific role, actions, and results. Finally, I created a section that spotlighted the skills he'd learned and honed while in that role.

Early Life Experiences

From a young age, Thierry demonstrated a true passion for finance. He began following the stock market in middle school, started a salsa business in high school, and invested his profits from that business in the stock market. Briefly telling this story demonstrates that his career choice was far from arbitrary. This internal motivation distinguishes him from the graduates who enter a given field due to income potential, parental pressure, or lack of direction.
